On 12/19/63, [redacted]
Electrical Workers Union Local 716, Houston, Texas, advised
SA JERRY C. DANIEL his files contained no record identifiable
with HUBERT GARDNER. He stated Baytown, Texas, is covered by
Electrical Workers Union Local 527 in Galveston, Texas.

[redacted] Credit Bureau of Greater
Houston, advised that her files contained an inquiry from
Lake Charles, Louisiana, dated 10/17/63 regarding GARDNER
but the Credit Bureau at Houston was unable to locate GARDNER.

[redacted] International
Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 527, Galveston,
Texas, advised SA CARLOS V. KIRBY, JR., on 12/19/63 that
their files reflect H. J. GARDNER, Social Security Number T-
408-26-4019, had worked out of that local but the files do
not reflect an address for GARDNER. He advised that GARDNER
was last employed by Fishbach and Moore, electrical contractors
in Houston, Texas, but he left this employment on 11/13/63.
He stated there was no indication that GARDNER had been
employed since that time.

[REDACTED] advised he believed GARDNER usually worked out of Local 861 in Lake Charles, Louisiana.

On 12/20/63, [REDACTED], Fishbach and Moore, Houston, Texas, advised that H. J. GARDNER had worked for that company until 11/13/63. His records reflect no address other than the local electrical union in Lake Charles, Louisiana. A check was made with fellow workers of GARDNER and no information could be developed regarding his present location.

On 12/20/63 POLLY FRAZIER, Houston Police Department Identification Division, stated the Police Department had identification record for one HUBERT J. GARDNER, Houston Police Department Number Q08977, Houston Bulletin Number 5249, which showed GARDNER was wanted for [REDACTED] in Lake Charles, Louisiana (FHD).
