He could not recall BRACKEN's exact words, however, he did say something to the effec "it was not an isolated thing, that sort of thing exists in the minds of a group on the West Coast". BRACKEN further mentioned something about a "revolution" and that the group had "unlimited he did not pursue the matter financial support". as to what group BRACKEN was referring and BRACKEN did not explain as to what group he might be referring.
