The captioned individual, a GSA elevator operator in the Justice Building, visited Bureau Headquarters today and spoke to SA John W. O' Beirne of the Crime Research Section. He advised he is a veteran and receives medical treatment at Mt. Alto Hospital, Washington, D. C., out-patient clinic. Mr. Armstrong had an appointment 2-10-64 at 8 a.m. and while there spoke to a tall, slender, white man who had dark hair and appeared to be approximately 60 years of age. He said this man spoke with what sounded like an Irish accent. In the conversation Armstrong mentioned at one time years ago he lived in Dallas, Texas, and this unknown individual stated that he had been at the Municipal Building in Dallas prior to the President's assassination and knew what was going to happen and should have reported it but did not. Regarding establishing the identity of this person. Armstrong said at the time he was there there was only one other white person beside the man to whom he spoke. Armstrong had no other details concerning the person and thought that this was information which should be reported. The above was furnished telephonically to Supervisor Tucker of the Washington Field Office who indicated an appropriate inquiry would be made. RECOMMENDATION: For information. 1 - Mr Rosen
