Mrs. JOESTEN stated that he had never done a thing like this before and that she definitely feels that he is suffering from a nervous breakdown and that his statements about the assassination of the President are more figments of his imagination.

Mrs. JOESTEN advised that the last letter she received from her husband was dated 2/23/64 from Chez Morin, 7 Avenue F. Roosevelt, La Ciotat (B.d.R.), France, in which he stated he would be in Europe for several months. She advised that he also told her that he was going to Zurich, Switzerland, and that she should write care of GPO Foste, Zurich, Switzerland. Mrs. JOESTEN also stated that her husband has a sister, Professor LERSCH at Dreschstensonlumber 5, Munich 23, Germany, which is close by, and he probably would be visiting her.

Letterhead memorandum follows for Legats at Bonn, Paris, and Berne, requesting investigation to locate JOESTEN.
