Referenced airtel which enclosed FD-302 concerning an interview with George Colton was received at the Bureau and it was noted that the reproduction of this FD-302 in paragraph one contains several erasures which are visible and dissemination of the FD-302 cannot be made in its present form.

Cincinnati is instructed to prepare an amended FD-302 concerning the interview with George Colton and furnish appropriate corrected copies to Dallas, New Orleans, and the Bureau.

NOTE: This matter pertains to a letter dated 3/2/64, which was addressed to the Attorney General from George Colton of Fairpoint, Ohio. Colton's letter stated he was a former bartender at Baton Rouge and had overheard comments of one "Argoski" to the effect "down in Texas we kill them." Colton was subsequently interviewed by the Cincinnati Division and submitted an FD-302 which had corrections made and in reproducing, these corrections made a very sloppy appearance which cannot be disseminated to the President's Commission in present form. Cincinnati has been requested to submit an amended FD-302. There are leads presently outstanding in the New Orleans Division.
