Dear Mr. Hoover:

We have been informed by Mr. Sebastian F. Latona that the cartons found near the sixth floor window of the TSEB building at which the assassin apparently stood, bore nineteen identifiable latent fingerprints and six identifiable latent palmprints, in addition to the prints of Oswald. Could you please determine, as far as may be possible without the taking of new fingerprints, whether any of these latent prints were made by persons employed in the TSEB building on November 22, 1963.

We would appreciate it if you could furnish us with this information by March 31, 1964.
