Special Agent JAMES ADAMS, assigned to Federal Bureau of Investigation Headquarters, Washington, D.C., advised Special Agent JAMES P. WOOTEN of the WFO on December 7, 1963, information had been received that one WILLIAM I. TURNER had written a letter to the Atlanta Constitution newspaper, which letter reportedly states, "The President got what he deserved, Justice WARREN and the Attorney General are next." TURNER is reported to live in Warsaw, North Carolina.

The above information was furnished to Sergeant JESSE R. STONE of the Washington, D.C. Metropolitan Police Department, on December 7, 1963, by Special Agent WOOTEN. It is noted Jpecial Agent ADAMS advised this information previously furnished to the United States Secret Service and local authorities in Charlotte, North Carolina and Atlanta, Georgia.
