SAC, Johnson, Chicago, advised Saturday that Abraham Bolden's attorney (Bolden is the Chicago Secret Service Agent whom we are interviewing at the request of the President's Commission concerning his allegations of derelictions on the part of Secret Service Agents in connection with the protection of the President) announced to the press 5-23-64, that Bolden was to be interviewed by the FBI on Monday, 5-25-64.

Johnson advised that the press was asking him to confirm or deny this statement. Mr. DeLoach's Office, after checking, advised SAC Johnson that he could confirm that such interview would be conducted by the FBI at the request of the President's Commission.
