Enclosed for receiving offices is a copy of a self-explanatory, anonymous letter received at the Bureau on 5-18-64. The envelope enclosing this letter had a postmark which was illegible.

No information identifiable with Arizona license EZY 958 could be located in Bureau files.

Phoenix is instructed to endeavor to identify the unidentified individual referred to by the anonymous writer who was driving the 1954 or 1955 Packard, with the aforementioned Arizona license number. When an identification is made your indices should be checked and the Bureau advised with recommendations as to whether the individual should be interviewed.

Receiving offices should also alert appropriate local authorities to the implied threat against the Chief Justice. It is essential these agencies be cautioned we do not know the significance of the Arizona license number nor the authenticity of the implied threat.
