## ATTUIS HYBROL MIR.

On Key 25, 1964, Officer LEE FRANCIS LARSEN, Police Department, Choyenne, Myoning, edvised as follows:

On May 22, 1964, a call was received by the Cheyenne, Eyoning, Folice Department from the Selvation Army in Gieyenne, reporting that one LOHN JOSUIN RESID was drunk and causing a disturbance of the Selvation Army.

Officers LARSEN and ROBERT HILLIANS arrested [FAUTER] on the street near the Salvation Army, at approximately 5:22 p.m. that date. [AUTE] was very drunk, staggering and resisted arrest. It was necessary to use restraining devices to hear [AUTE] under control and take him to the police station.

While riding in the police car to the police station, REUTER stated, "I killed NERREDY. They got the wrong man. OSIMLD had nothing to do with it, and OSIMLD was just a punk. You guys think I am nuts but I know just exactly where I was and exactly what happened at the time," apparently referring to the assassingtion of Freeident KENTEDY.

At the booking deak, Officers IARSEA and WILLIAMS wore present when DRUDED made the additional statement that he "could have got JORSON and the one I am after and is CALBEATER." Officers JERRY MANRES, EDVAND HALLETER and JAMES BACKS were also believed to have been present when REUTED made these statements at the booking deak. REVIER was so drunk and balligerent at the time he made these statements that Officer LARSEN felt he should wait until he had had time to "sober up" to question him further concerning these statements.

REDITED also made a statement while at the booking desk to the effect that he wanted to be deported to Russia, wanted to "go Federal" and would admit snything.

LARSEN was of the opinion that the remarks made by REUIDE were those of a "crazy drunk" or a mental case.

At 4:00 p.m. on May 25, 1964, EFUTTE engested in Folice Court in Choyonne on charges of dramit, vagrancy and resisting arrest. He was fined \$100 on the resisting arrest charge. He paid \$75 of this fine, which money be had received by Western Union Money Order, number NK71949, on May 25, 1964, from his sister, Mrs. SOL/MOH DAVID Wellfleet, Massochusetts. The Court ordered that he commence serving time in the City Jail for the remaining \$25 fine.

Un May 25, 1964, [UNH JOSEIH RUUT. Just interviewed at the Cheyenne, Wyoming, Folice Department, indsmuch as he had indicated to Officer IARSEN that he wanted to go Federal", in an effort to determine any pertinent information and background concerning [REUD. ] and his possible criminal activities.

ENUTER advised that he is, in his opinion, an 'itinorant bus' and that he has not held a stordy job since Soytember. 1963.

UEUT Deald that when he was arrested by silleers of the Cheyune Folice Department on May 22, 1964, he was apparently 'crazy drunk." He said that on May 24, 1964, while being fingerprinted and photographed by Officer JEEN MANNERS, MANNERS had informed him that he had made statements to the effect that he had killed President KEENEDY, that he could have gotten President JOHNSON and intended to get GULDWATER. He said he does not recall making any of these statements and that he has certainly never had any such ideas to run through his mind when he was sober.

in said that when he is drinking he often says and does things which he cannot later remember and does not know why he makes such remarks because he does not mean them, but that this apparently is his way of getting back at people when he is drunk and gets the impression that he is being pushed around. He said that when he is drunk he has been told that he even hates his best friend.

RLUTER advised that communism is the lowest type of balief in his opinion and he feels that envine who would believe in such doctrines is stupid. REUTER said he has never felt any sort of hatred toward the President of the United States or Senator BARRY COLDEMTER.

He said that the only thing that he can think of as to the reason why he may have made the above statements is that he was drinking in a bar in Cheycane just prior to his arrest, where he because very drunk, and that he may have overheard conversation concerning politics, which may have prompted his "drunken mind" to build up such thoughts.

REUTER advised that on November 22, 1963, the data on which Fresident JOHN F. KENNEDY was assassinated at Dallas, Texas, he, REUTER, was working on Watson Island at Hismi, Florida, for the Goodyear Company under the supervision of Ceptain NEALEY (a civilian, first name unrecalled), Filot in Charge, and Crew Chief JOE HICK. He said his duties were bandling lines to blimps.
