WILLIAM TURNER; THREAT AGAINST PRESIDENT.

ON INSTANT DATE CHARLES A. DOLLINGER THREE ZERO TWO EAST JAY STREET, NEWTON, N.C. TELEPHONICALLY ADVISED THAT HE IS CURRENTLY STAYING AT THE HOLIDAY INN MOTEL, REISTERSTOWN RD. BALTIMORE COUNTY, MD. DOLLINGER SAYS LAST EVENING HE ENGAGED IN CONVERSATION WITH WILLIAM TURNER WHO RESIDES EITHER ON HENRY ALDEN ROAD OR CHURCH LANE, BALTIMORE AND IS POSSIBLY IN CONTRACTING BUSINESS. CONVERSATION TOOK PLACE AT SPAULDING BAR ON REISTERSTOWN RD. AND IN ARGUMENT THAT INVOLVED ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY TURNER SAID PRESIDENT KENNEDY SHOULD HAVE BEEN SHOT. DOLLINGER SAYS HE TOLD TURNER NO ONE COULD SHOOT A MAN, PARTICULARLY A PRESIDENT. TURNER SAID HE COULD AND WOULD SHOOT A PRESIDENT AND COULD AND WOULD SHOOT PRESIDENT JOHNSON, IF NECESSARY. DOLLINGER COULD NOT EXPLAIN HOW HE HAD OBTAINED ADDRESSES OF TURNER BUT SAID TURNER GAVE HIM HIS NAME.

SECRET SERVICE AGENT WILLIAM HOLMES NOTIFIED OF ABOVE AT TEN A.M. INSTANT DATE.
