ReWFOlet to the Bureau 5-15-64, captioned "Presley J. Walton, Information Concerning."

Miami is instructed to prepare a letterhead memorandum incorporating the information furnished to you by WFO in referenced letter. Your memorandum should be suitable for dissemination to both the President's Commission and Secret Service. Include in your memorandum any additional pertinent information contained in your files concerning Walton and any additional data from reliable sources which would reveal Walton's mental instability.

Insure that your memorandum is correct to preclude any revisions or corrections at the Bureau and furnish Dallas appropriate inserts.

Enclosed for your information is a copy of a letterhead memorandum captioned "Cuban Activities in the United States, Internal Security - CU" prepared by the Louisville Division which appears to relate to Walton. Bureau files reveal a letter by Presley J. Walton, who may be identical to the above individual, dated July 1, 1959, addressed to "The Honorable Earl K. Long, Governor of State of Louisiana" which is critical and nonsensical. (109-480-1708) (62-105614) *62-109060-3173*

to the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court and an additional magnetic tape. Schade requested the Bureau review this material and that it be returned to him. He did not desire a transcript of the tapes but wanted the Bureau to be aware of what was in them. The tapes were reviewed, one of which furnished the date of 2-29-64 and is addressed to President Johnson. His letters and a tape appear to be those prepared by an individual who is mentally unstable and makes several references to former President Kennedy and other individuals.
