Q580 Envelope (postmark illegible), bearing typewritten address "Mr. J. Edgar Hoover Federal Bureau of Investigation Washington, D. C.," and accompanying two-page typewritten letter headed "Federal Bureau of Investigation Washington, D. C." beginning "Gentlemen: A while back I overheard..." and ending "...people in public office. Sincerely, A Citizen"

Result of examination:

The typewriting on Q580 was not identified in the Anonymous Letter File. A photograph of this exhibit will be added to this file.

The typewriting on Q580 matches most closely the Laboratory standard for a Corona pica style of type, spaced ten letters per inch.

The envelope and paper comprising Q580 does not contain any watermarks, indented writings, or other significant features which would indicate the source of the paper.

The postmark on the envelope in Q580 appears to be "ALBUQUERQUE TR 8 MAY 15 1964 R P O," although the "ALBUQUERQUE" portion of the postmark is quite faint.

You will be separately advised on the latent fingerprint examination of Q580.
