MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION
CONCERNING

On June 13, 1964, Reverend Elton L. Stephenson, Chaplain, Methodist Hospital, Houston, Texas, residence 9223 Fordshire, furnished the following information:

On June 2, 1964, Reverend Stephenson obtained fifty one dollar bills from the University State Bank in Houston, Texas. On June 13, 1964, he noticed that one of these bills had the following statement hand printed in ink around the border of the reverse side: "Help! Kennedy will be shot Nov 22, 1963 Warn him please!"

Two other bills have mustaches drawn on Washington's picture as does the bill with the above statement on it. One of the bills has a swastika drawn on Washington's forehead. Reverend Stephenson stated he knew nothing further regarding the source of these bills or the identity of the writer who placed the statement on the bill. He turned the bills over to the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
