Note:

Schlang, a mental case, came to the attention of the Philadelphia Office on 6/18/64, after he had been arrested for annoying women. After arrest he indicated he knew who was responsible for the assassination of President Kennedy. Because of Schlang's mental illness, no further investigation is desired. However, the investigation already conducted by Philadelphia should be appropriately reported inasmuch as his allegation is similar to other such nebulous complaints received and indicates the amount of work required as a result of the assassination.
