MISCELLANEOUS - INFORMATION CONCERNING.

Enclosed are the original and two Photostats of a letter addressed to the American Embassy in Bad Godesberg, Germany, under date of May 22, 1964, by Mr. Heinz Otremba, of 30 Neubergstrasse, Wuerzburg, Germany.

Also enclosed is the original and two Photostats of an English translation of that letter made by the translation bureau at the Embassy.

The letter refers to the possibility that Harvey Lee Oswald appeared as a spectator in a motion picture scene made during a meeting addressed by President Kennedy in Texas before his election to the presidency. This scene appeared in a West German television program shown on May 22, 1964.

We have determined through the facilities of the United States Information Service here that the television program was obtained in its entirety by the local network from the American Broadcasting Company of New York City and was shown by that company under the title, "The Making of a President."

Mr. Otremba's letter was acknowledged by this office. The attached is submitted for the Bureau's information and its consideration of the advisability of viewing this American film, with particular reference to the sequence referred to by Otremba.
