ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT  
JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY  
11-22-63, DALLAS, TEXAS  
MISC. - INFO CONCERNING

ReLAtel 11-23-63, 1:22 a.m., captioned "Assassina-  
tion of President John F. Kennedy, 11-22-63," instructing  
that Milo Elroy Stormo, an employee of General Dynamics  
residing at 6408 Imca Road, Fort Worth, be interviewed.

No subsequent information on Stormo could be  
located in Bureau files. As you will recall Dallas was  
advised on 11-22-63, by the Industrial Security Section  
of General Dynamics that a 1958 four-door white Lincoln  
bearing 1963 California license W 662 was observed leaving  
the vicinity of Carswell Air Force Base at a high rate of  
speed as President Kennedy's plane took off en route to  
Dallas. San Francisco advised the above license was  
registered to Stormo.

Advise results of investigation and indicate  
whether this matter has been subsequently reported under  
the above caption.
