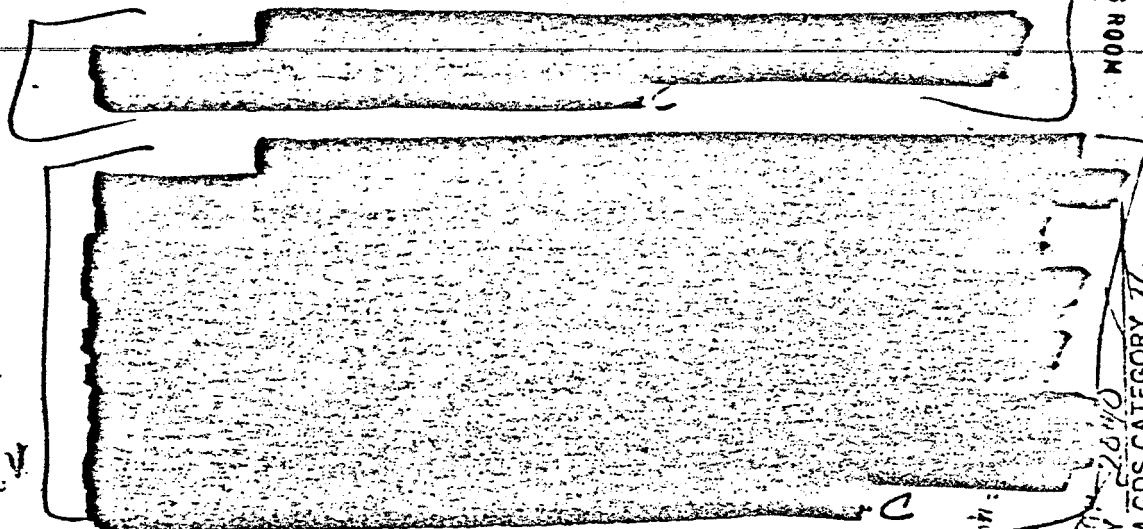

For your information we are aware Featherston is a U. S. citizen and claims to be a newspaperman. In recent years he has been in British Honduras at various times and was engaged in clandestine activities in that country and is well known to British authorities. In 1959, it was reported he was allegedly involved in a plot to assassinate the President of Guatemala and during the same year had made speeches in support of the Castro regime. At one time he was employed by the

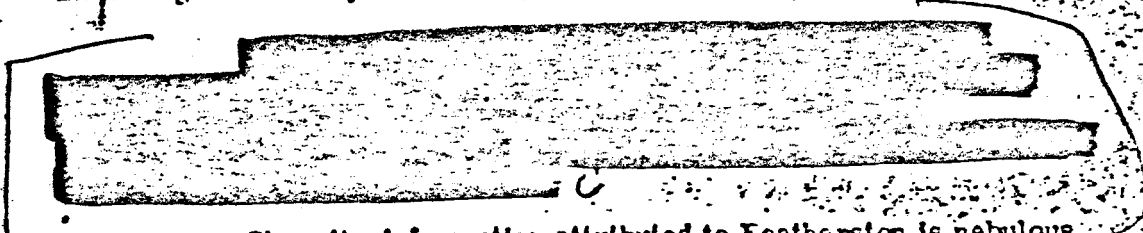
