We do not think Leon Hubert and Eddie Barker are reliable sources for trial evidence. Why we remind the Warren Commission that we have not only a record of all previous FBI and Commission trial balloons, but also the record of the Zapruder film.

Since the Connally bullet (formerly bullet #2, now bullet #1) has already been determined as too fragmented for unique identification with the rifle found in the Texas Book Building and, since the fatal Kennedy bullet (formerly bullet #3, now bullet #2) has also been determined as beyond unique identification with the same rifle, the Commission is face-to-face with a rifle which in a court of law could not be regarded as substantial evidence in the case of the assassination of the President of the United States.

Therefore, since the bullets (#1 and #2) which struck John F. Kennedy and John Connally on November 22, 1963, can not be linked legitimately to the rifle found by the Dallas police inside the Texas School Book Depository Building, we require that the Commission produce bullet #3 (formerly the fatal bullet) which according to the "leaked" source close to Commission affairs is lying somewhere "lost in the Texas grass." This bullet, since it hit no one, may still be intact and, therefore, the only bullet uniquely identifiable with the rifle found in the Book Building.

Can the Warren Commission produce this bullet?
