> Assassination of President John Fitzgerald Kennedy, November 22, 1963, Dallas Texas

Doctor Irving James Thorne, 14 East 56th Street, New York, New York, advised on July 2, 1964, that he is a general surgeon and has never practiced or treated anyone in the state of Arizona.

Doctor Thorne advised that he had a very close friend, Doctor Edward Blank, who was a noted psychiatrist in Arizona, and that he, Doctor Thorne, had planned to go into practice with him. He advised that he applied for his license in the state of Arizona, but had changed his mind and never completed his application.

Doctor Thorne advised that Doctor Blank is presently attached to State Hospital at Stockton, California, and resides at 500 West Alpine Avenue, apartment 202, Stockton, California.

Doctor Thorne felt that if Doctor Blank was contacted, he would know if there was any Doctor Thorn practicing psychiatry in Arizona during 1953.
