NOTE:

An anonymous letter was put in the prisoners' mail box, U. S. Penitentiary Leavenworth, which indicated an inmate by the name of Andrews had knowledge of the assassination 31 days prior to the assassination and that the same individual spoke of the death of President Johnson. A copy of the anonymous letter was furnished U. S. Secret Service and the LHM furnished by Kansas City was not suitable for dissemination. Kansas City was instructed 6/24/64 to submit revisions and corrections, however, the revisions have not been received to date.
