An anonymous letter was put in the prisoners' mail box, U. S. Penitentiary Leavenworth, which indicated an inmate by the name of Andrews had knowledge of the assassination 3 days prior to the assassination and that the same individual spoke of the death of President Johnson. A copy of the anonymous letter was furnished U.S. Secret Service and the LHM furnished by Kansas City was not suitable for dissemination. Kansas City was instructed 6/24/64 to submit revisions and corrections, however, the revisions have not been received to date.
