Assassination of President Kennedy

DEAR SIR;

THE ASSASSINATION OF THE LATE PRESIDENT, JOHN F. KENNEDY WAS INDEED A GREAT LOSS TO OUR COUNTRY AND TO OTHERS AS WELL. REALIZING THE EFFORT YOUR DEPARTMENT AND OTHER DEPARTMENTS HAVE PUT FORTH TO BRING FORTH JUSTICE AND AN END TO THE MYSTERIES OF THE LUNATIC L.H. OSWALD, I SINCERELY HOPE MY FINDINGS HAVE ALREADY BEEN EVALUATED.

HAVING BEEN SENT TO THIS COUNTRY (VIETNAM) ON 27 APRIL 1964, I WAS A REGULAR CUSTOMER AT THE CAROUSEL BAR IN SAIGON UNTIL 1 MAY 1964. REALIZING OUR MISSION WITH THESE PEOPLE, I TRIED GAINING THEIR CONFIDENCE. BY DOING THIS, ONE OF THE BAR MAID'S IN CONVERSATION WITH ME ON 30 APRIL 1964, QUESTIONED ME AS: "DID ANYONE IN AMERICA EVER STOP TO THINK THAT MADAME NHU COULD HAVE BEEN THE CONSPIRATRICE BEHIND THE ASSASSINATION OF MR. KENNEDY? SHE WAS IN THIS DALLAS, TEXAS, AND SHE DIDN'T LIKE THE PRESIDENT." UNQUOTE.
