Please re-interview Mr. Jess Willard Lynch to determine what relevance, if any, he believes the information he provided in Page, Arizona, on December 3, 1963 has to the assassination of President Kennedy or Lee Harvey Oswald. In that regard, please inform the Commission how Mr. Lynch originally came to be interviewed.

If, upon re-interview, Mr. Lynch provides an explanation of a possible relationship between Mrs. Bertha Cheek, Earlene Roberts or Jack Ruby and the assassination of President Kennedy, please provide Mr. Lynch's criminal record and any other information which might bear upon his general credibility or bias toward Mrs. Cheek, Earlene Roberts or Jack Ruby.
