ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY, NOVEMBER TWENTYTWO, NINETEEN SIXTYTHREE, DALLAS, TEXAS, MISCELLANEOUS DASH INFORMATION CONCERNING.

FOLLOWING LETTER RECEIVED IN BUREAU DATED JULY TWO, NINETEEN SIXTYFOUR, FORT WORTH, TEXAS: QUOTE I HAVE INFORMATION ABOUT THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY. I NOTIFIED THE F. B. I. LAST SEPTEMBER THAT I HAD THIS INFORMATION. IF ACTION HAD BEEN TAKEN AT THAT TIME THE PRESIDENT WOULD NOT HAVE BEEN KILLED. BUT INSTEAD I WAS THREATENED INTO SILENCE. NOW THIS INFORMATION IS BEING CHECKED BY THE F. B. I. BUT IT IS BEING CHECKED BY ONE OF THE F. B. I. MEN WHO WAS INVOLVED IN THREATENING ME LAST OCTOBER WITH MY BEING ARRESTED IF I DID NOT KEEP QUIET. ANY ONE WITH COMMON HORSE SENSE WOULD KNOW THAT SUCH PERSON IS NOT GOING TO PROVE THAT HE THREATENED ME INTO SILENCE. IF OTHER ARRANGEMENTS ARE NOT MADE THIS INFORMATION WILL BE WASTED AND

THE TRUTH WILL NEVER COME OUT.

RE: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY

QUOTE I SHALL WRITE TO EVERYONE POSSIBLE AND EXPOSE THIS ATTEMPT OF INJUSTICE ON THE PART OF THE F. B. I. FOR NO MAN IS GOING TO TURN UP EVIDENCE WHICH WILL CONVICT HIMSELF AND TAKE AWAY HIS JOB.

QUOTE I HOPE THAT YOU WILL TAKE NOTE OF THIS AND TAKE ACTION TO HAVE AN HONEST INVESTIGATION MADE. FOR THIS ONE NOW IS PAREN ONE BIG JOKE END PAREN OR RATHER IT IS ONE BIG FARSE. END QUOTE.

THIS COMMUNICATION BORE TYPED NAME OF DEAN W. MC ADAMS. ⁴ ₂ ⁴ FOUR TWO FOUR COLLEGE AVENUE, FORT WORTH, TEXAS. MC ADAMS MAY BE IDENTICAL ^{WITH} SUBJECT OF YOUR FILE SEVEN DASH FIVE TWO FOUR AND NINETEEN SIXTYFOUR EXTORTION CASE CAPTIONED QUOTE DEAN WASHINGTON MC ADAMS, RACHEL ELVINA CANDAGE DASH VICTIM. END QUOTE. IMMEDIATELY INTERVIEW MC ADAMS RELATIVE TO ALLEGED INFORMATION IN HIS POSSESSION AND FURNISH BUREAU TELETYPE SUMMARY OF RESULTS. FURNISH SPECIFIC ADVICE CONCERNING HIS ALLEGATIONS AGAINST BUREAU PERSONNEL. FOLLOW WITH DETAILED LETTERHEAD MEMORANDUM SUITABLE FOR TRANSMISSION TO THE PRESIDENTS COMMISSION FURNISHING FULL BACKGROUND RE MC ADAMS AND HIS POSSIBLE MENTAL STATE.

NOTE:

McAdams in letter to the Director dated 7-2-64 indicates he has information concerning the assassination and specifically alleges he was threatened by an FBI Agent if he did not keep quiet. Our files indicate McAdams is probably identical with an individual who has been the subject of an extortion case in 1964 and furnished false information with respect to a kidnaping in 1957. He corresponded in 1962 with the Bureau relative to a so-called "communist movement" in Fort Worth, Texas. Prosecution has been declined by U. S. Attorney's Office in Texas in view of the fact that McAdams is blind and obviously mentally deranged. In view of his allegations, however, and his threat to engage in a letter-writing campaign to "expose" these injustices, Dallas is being instructed to interview him and get the full facts.
