ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY,

NOVEMBER TWENTY TWO, SIXTY THREE, DALLAS, TEXAS, MISCELLANEOUS - INFORMATION CONCERNING.

RESDAIRTEL AUGUST ONE, LAST, CONCERNING INFORMATION FROM PCI THAT UNIDENTIFIED MALE BRAGGED HE WAS IN POSSESSION OF STOLEN DEATH CERTIFICATE OF LATE PRESIDENT KENNEDY AND THAT HE INTENDS TO REALIZE PROFIT BY MAKING COPIES AND SELLING THEM.

SAN DIEGO IMMEDIATELY DEVELOPE FULL DETAILS FROM PCI, ENDEAVOR TO IDENTIFY UNIDENTIFIED MALE AND IF FEASIBLE WITHOUT COMPROMISING PCI, INTERVIEW HIM CONCERNING ALLEGATION AND FURNISH RESULTS TO BUREAU AND DALLAS IN LETTERHEAD MEMORANDUM WITHOUT PROPERTY STAMP FOR POSSIBLE DISSEMINATION. INSURE PCI APPROPRIATELY CHARACTERIZED AS TO RELIABILITY. MAIL COPY TO DALLAS.
