On June 12, 1964, [REDACTED] Shepherdsville, Kentucky, (Protect Identity) advised SA DONALD L. SMITH that he could furnish no information regarding the writer of the letter postmarked at Shepherdsville, Kentucky, which was sent to Austin, Texas, regarding the assassination of the President. It is possible someone was passing through Shepherdsville and dropped the letter in the post office, as it is noted it was dated April 22, 1964, Louisville. Shepherdsville is about 21 miles south of Louisville.

On June 12, 1964, [REDACTED] United States Post Office, Shepherdsville, Kentucky, (Protect Identity), advised SA SMITH that she recalls a letter going through this post office, which had an address regarding the KENNEDY assassination. She could not say for sure the one postmarked April 22, 1964 at Shepherdsville was the one, although it probably was. She could furnish no information regarding the writer of the letter and did not recognize the handwriting.
