The Dallas Office is endeavoring, during the week of August 3 to 7, to submit reports in the RUBY case, which will be approximately 100 pages, the OSWALD case, approximately 200 pages, and the Assassination case, approximately 100 pages.

In addition, at the request of the President's Commission, a transcript of the radio transmissions of the Dallas Police Department during the period 10:00 A.M. to 3:00 P.M. on November 22, 1963, and the period 10:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. on November 24, 1963, is being typed, which it is anticipated, will run approximately 200 pages.
