"I no all details of President Kenndy who did the job. it was wall street and the Ku Klux Klan Goldwater will not be President but he will be assassinated on the same day Kenndy was assassinated.

On July 30, 1964, Mr. Frank J. Geyer was interviewed at his residence, Room 27, Crystal Hotel, 1110 North Clark Street, Chicago, Illinois. Mr. Geyer stated he wrote a letter to the Federal Bureau of Investigation in Washington, D.C. on about July 21, 1964, containing the above information. Mr. Geyer viewed a copy of this letter and acknowledged that it was written by him. Mr. Geyer stated he is retired and spends a considerable amount of his time thinking about politics and the world situation. He stated he not only thinks about these matters, but he "dreams" about them. He stated he has the ability, after thinking about a problem, to dream about it and come up with a solution to the problem.

Mr. Geyer stated he had a dream concerning the assassination of President Kennedy in which he heard a young girl calling him, looked up to a window and saw a picture of Lee Harvey Oswald. Mr. Geyer stated this, in his opinion, confirmed the fact that Lee Harvey Oswald was the individual responsible for the assassination of President Kennedy. Mr. Geyer stated that he felt that Wall Street and the Ku Klux Klan, persons opposed to the civil rights bill, possibly influenced Oswald to commit this crime.

Mr. Geyer stated that Senator Barry Goldwater will be assassinated on the same day as President Kennedy, year not known. He stated that this was strictly his opinion and was based on the fact that Goldwater was opposed to many of the things held in esteem by President Kennedy, such as civil rights.

Mr. Geyer stated he had no specific knowledge concerning the assassination of President Kennedy or his belief that Senator Barry Goldwater would be assassinated. He explained that he was a dreamer and philosopher and had the ability to analyze situations, and the above was his opinion concerning them.

Mr. Geyer stated he had no specific knowledge concerning the assassination of President Kennedy or his belief that Senator Barry Goldwater would be assassinated.
