Re report of SA G. Randall McGough dated 7-30-64 at Tampa.

Page five of referenced report sets forth information indicating that Dewey M. Taft was in the process of preparing an issue of "American Digest," which would headline the fact that Bobby Kennedy had his brother, John F. Kennedy, shot, that Ruby and Oswald were in on the deal, that they tried to kill Retired General Walker before assassinating the President. This information along with a characterization of Taft and the National States Rights Party (NSRP) should be set forth in a letterhead memorandum captioned "Assassination of President John Fitzgerald Kennedy, 11-22-63, Dallas, Texas, Miscellaneous - Information Concerning."

In addition to furnishing copies of the letterhead memorandum to the Bureau for dissemination to the President's Commission, appropriate copies should be furnished to Dallas, which office is origin in the assassination case.
