Frank LNU had learned that one A. Schneider (phonetic) had secured a stolen death certificate of President Kennedy's and was going to duplicate this certificate in an effort to sell them at a profit. San Diego's PCI has been instructed to endeavor to identify the parties involved. From information available to the Bureau, the President's death certificate was prepared at Parkland Memorial Hospital in Dallas. How a copy or the original could come into the possession of anyone is not known. The United States Sercret Service reportedly obtained all pertinent personal material relating to the President which included the death certificate. When additional pertinent data is developed, the Commission and Secret Service will be accordingly advised.
