NOTE:

San Diego PCI furnished information that one [Frank LNU] had learned that one [A. Schneider] (phonetic) had secured a stolen death certificate of President Kennedy's and was going to duplicate this certificate in an effort to sell them at a profit. San Diego's PCI has been instructed to endeavor to identify the parties involved. From information available to the Bureau, [the President's death certificate was prepared at Parkland Memorial Hospital in Dallas. How a copy or the original could come into the possession of anyone is not known.] The United States Secret Service reportedly obtained all pertinent personal material relating to the President which included the [death certificate.] When additional pertinent data is developed, the Commission and Secret Service will be accordingly advised.
