The Bundeskriminalamt - (BKA - West German Federal Criminal Police) was asked to arrange to have ALFRED HILLER interviewed. The BKA has furnished the enclosed report of that interrogation prepared 6/25/64 by the Criminal Police office of the State Police Direction for North Wuerttemberg at Stuttgart, Germany.

It is requested that the enclosed be translated. It will not be necessary to translate page 2 of the enclosed as that page is a retranslation of the enclosure to relet. Also, it will not be necessary to translate the form which is page 4 of the enclosed.

The report shows that HILLER has a history of mental disturbance and that his claimed knowledge of the assassination is based on dreams. He was in the University Nerve Clinic in Tuebingen from 4/8/64 to 6/5/64. His doctor there says that HILLER suffers from schizophrenia and that his "visions and dream predictions" are symptoms of this condition.
