**RE: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY**

"Certain details" be allegedly possessed concerning the assassination. Results of investigation should be incorporated in appropriate inserts, 24 for Dallas, for inclusion in a subsequent report by Dallas. You should insure your inserts incorporate the translated letter and make appropriate comment concerning this matter is being referred to the Bureau for investigation.

Every effort should be made to expedite this investigation as the President's Commission, investigating the assassination, is endeavoring to wind up its inquiries at an early date.

**NOTE:** The translated letter does not give any indication as to the knowledge possessed by the writer. It would appear Dragomir may be a teacher at a Catholic theological school in Salzburg, Austria. In view of alleged information, it is felt we have the responsibility of checking it out and subsequently furnishing it to the Commission.
