Enclosed for Minneapolis and Dallas are copies of a self-explanatory, envelope, communication and true copy of same received at the Bureau on 8-7-64, from Jerome J. Landvik.

No information identifiable with Landvik could be located in Bureau files.

Landvik should be located and interviewed concerning his admission. The results of investigation should be incorporated in appropriate inserts and furnished to the Bureau and Dallas, 25 copies to Dallas for inclusion in a subsequent report by Dallas in the above-caption. Minneapolis should also include in the inserts a true copy of the communication and envelope from Landvik as well as information relating to its receipt at the Bureau. Any readily available information relating to the possible mental instability of Landvik should also be included in the inserts.

Expedite, and be sure Landvik's letter acknowledged.

NOTE: Landvik's note is undated but was received in an envelope postmarked at Minneapolis, Minnesota, on 8-5-64. Landvik in effect states that although he was in Minneapolis at the time President Kennedy was assassinated, he nevertheless feels he had something to do with the assassination. While it is quite apparent Landvik may be a mental case, it is felt we have the responsibility to check this matter out in view of his "admission." The results of this inquiry will be subsequently reported by Dallas and disseminated to the President's Commission.
