Dear Mr. Rankin:

Reference is made to your letter dated August 11, 1964, requesting investigation of an allegation made by Miss Eugenia J. Williams of Tuskegee Institute, Alabama. Reference is also made to my letter dated August 12, 1964, transmitting copies of the Dallas report of Special Agent Robert P. Gemberling dated August 7, 1964, captioned Assassination of President John Fitzgerald Kennedy, November 22, 1963, Dallas, Texas.

We have previously conducted investigation of substantially the same allegation made by Miss Williams in her communication enclosed with your August 11, 1964, letter. The results of this investigation are incorporated in Special Agent Gemberling's August 7, 1964, report, pages 10-14. For your information, the above report discloses that Miss Williams' mother, Mrs. Corrie Williams during an interview on July 7, 1964, advised that her daughter has been mentally ill for the past fourteen years and was currently receiving psychiatric treatment.

In view of our prior investigation and the reported mental condition of Miss Williams, no further action will be taken in this matter unless advised to the contrary by you.

reporting of this matter by Dallas is desired.

NOTE:

Williams, a mental case, has telephonically
contacted our Mobile and WFO offices on several occasions
alleging that the wife of James T. Bray (a Veterans
Administration hospital employee in Tuskegee, Alabama),
admitted planning the assassination of President Kennedy
to her and that Mr. Bray and his brother, Dr. Edward T.
Bray, also knew about this. This is the same allegation
referred to by the Commission in its 8-11-64, letter.
Since we have already logically investigated and reported
this matter, no further action appears necessary.
