Houston should intensify efforts to locate and interview [redacted] specifically concerning the statements attributed to him appearing on Page 2, Paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 of your letterhead memorandum. The results of all investigation should be incorporated in appropriate inserts for transmittal to Dallas for inclusion in a subsequent report in captioned matter. Furnish one copy for Bureau's information and 25 copies of your inserts to Dallas.

El Paso received information from the U. S. Army on 7-30-64, which was furnished to Houston reflecting that on [redacted]

[redacted] had made statements causing him to form the opinion that [redacted] was a "far right extremist." [redacted] allegedly stated Oswald and Ruby were communist agents, President Kennedy and Johnson were tools and sympathizers of the communist movement, President Kennedy was ordered assassinated by communists and that Ruby was ordered by communists to kill Oswald. [redacted] allegedly can prove these statements. Houston is endeavoring to identify and locate Dr. Martin for interview. When the results of investigation are obtained, they will be reported by Dallas for subsequent dissemination to the President's Commission.
