On 8/12/64, Dr. [redacted] Supervising Psychiatrist of Building C & D, Kings Park State Hospital, Kings Park, Long Island, advised that he reads all patients' outgoing mail. He stated however, that it was very easy for a patient to slip a letter out of the hospital without his seeing it. *NY*

Dr. [redacted] requested that he be given copies of the letters in question so that he might examine the handwriting which possibly might be familiar to him.

This was done and on August 20, 1964, Dr. [redacted] advised he was unable to identify the handwriting. He also stated that none of the names listed in the anonymous letters were present or ever had been patients at this hospital.
