SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY  
MISCELLANEOUS - INFORMATION CONCERNING

At 1:18a. m., Mr. Albert Jenner, President's Commission, telephonically advised that the process relative to Professor Revilo Oliver has been forwarded to U. S. Marshal Henry C. George, Post Office and Federal Court Building, Danville, Illinois. George's home address is 917 Kingdom Avenue, Danville. Jenner stated George has been informed that Professor Oliver's whereabouts if established he, George, will be so advised either by Jenner or the Springfield FBI Office. According to Jenner, George will then promptly serve the process on Oliver.

Jenner requested that the Springfield FBI Office be advised of the above information. He requested that George be notified when Oliver is located.

ACTION:

At 1:40 a. m., Duty Clerk Dave Kapp of the Springfield Office was furnished above information and instructed to promptly advise the Bureau and then U. S. Marshal George when Professor Oliver is located.

ADDENDUM:

Jenner called from New York at 12:50 p. m., 9/6/64, stated he was now in New York City and would remain in periodic telephone contact with the Bureau.
