Norfolk is instructed to immediately submit results of interview with Erich Lintrop.

The President's Commission has furnished the report concerning the assassination of former President Kennedy to President Johnson and all phases of investigation pending must be handled immediately and all investigation reported.

If results of your investigation have already been furnished to the Bureau, advise date submitted; otherwise, results of your investigation are to reach the Bureau on or before September 30, 1964.

NOTE: New York received information from Secret Service that Lintrop approached two Florida Highway Patrolmen who escorted him back to his hotel in Jacksonville, Florida, after he had been drinking. While en route, Lintrop was alleged to have said he knew Jack Ruby, Lee Harvey Oswald, and also the "money man." He would not divulge the name of the money man but stated he lived in Pakistan. Investigation determined Lintrop is employed aboard the S. S. American Flyer, U. S. Lines. He indicated when in Constantinople, Turkey, several days following the assassination, he spoke with a Turkish Army officer who told him there were rumors in Turkey that Madame Nhu of South Vietnam

was responsible for the assassination. Lintrop stated he has never met Lee Harvey Oswald or Jack Ruby and knows nothing of the assassination other than what he read in the newspapers. As the report of the assassination has been furnished to the President, this matter should be handled expeditiously.
