ATJ: A Callive received numerous complaints relating to individuals other than Lee Harvey Cavald. The complaints generally relate to remarks and throats allegedly made by the individuals concerning their feelings about President Konnedy, other officials and the policies of the administration. The complaints are initiated by cranks, mental cases and patriotic citizens. This will be the eighth such report disseminated to the President's Commission. A copy will be disseminated to the Department and U. S. Secret Service separately. The enclosed report has been reviewed by Ir. Felmont, Malley and appropriate Dureau supervisor.
