Enclosed for the Bureau are ten copies of a letterhead memo regarding letters by LEO A. GORMAN and information about him.

Los Angeles attached the nonsensical letters of GORMAN directed to the Los Angeles Office in order that anyone seeing these could make an appropriate evaluation of GORMAN.

In view of GORMAN's obvious mental instability and unreliability, he was not interviewed.

SAs LANFORD L. BLANTON and PHILLIP B. DEILY conducted all investigation in letterhead memo with the exception of credit and criminal checks, which were conducted by SA MARK LAPE THOMPSON.

GORMAN's writing "An Analysis of the Character of the Assassin of President John F. Kennedy" was not set forth in the enclosed letterhead memo since it was previously reported in Los Angeles report of SA CHESTER G. ORTON captioned, "LEE HARVEY OSWALD, aka. IS-R-CUBA," 7/30/64.
