ASSACEINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITTIGERALD IDENHEDY NOVEMBER 22, 1963 BALLAS, TEXAS

Re: Warren Egbert Hefflon

A complaint was filed by Epecial Agent Harold V. Brucggeman of the FBI on September 15, 1964, before United States Commissioner K. V. Fuelling, Cedar Rapids, Iova, charging Warren Egbert Refflon, also known as Renni Agro, with violation of Title 18, Section 2312, United States Code. Hefflon at this time was in custody of the sheriff, Toledo, Iowa, after having been arrested by the Folice Department, Tama, Iova, in possession of a 1962 Chevrolet convertible, California license HCU 945, which had been reported stolen on or about July 24, 1964, at Los Angeles, California.

A warrant was issued and Mefflon was taken into custody by Deputy United States Barshal Dick D. McKinney on September 15, 1964, and brought before United States Commissioner, Cedar Rapids, Iova, at which time bond was set at \$1,500.00. Herflon immediately requested the services of an attorney, and arrangements were made for appointment of an attorney through the United States District Court, Cedar Rapids, Iova. While in the custody of Deputy United States Harshal Licking on September 15, 1964, Hefflon, according to Eckinney, started making irrational statements. He claimed he was deaf and was unable to hear the Harshal. He also claimed he was unable to write. He objected strenuously to being fingerprinted, claiming no one had the right to fingerprint him. He stated he was going to avail himself of all the "foolish rights" bestoved upon him by the United States Government. While in the Harshal's office at Cedar Rapids, Hefflon observed a picture of former President John F. Kennedy and suddenly made the statement, "I killed him." Defore the United States Commissioner, Cedar Rapids, on September 17, 1961, he acknowledged he had made such a statement upon being asked a direct question by United States Attorney Donald 3. O'Drien.

## Hefflon is described as follows:

Varren Egbert Hefflon Caucasian liale Race Sex Birth July 16, 1933, at New London, Connecticut Neight 5' 10" -Veight 202 pounds Hair **Black** Eyes Brown Residence RFD, Tama, Iowa

Refflon is married, and his wife, Glaine Ferneau Hefflon, resides at Tama.

United States Attorney O'Brien advised on September 17, 1964, he is giving serious consideration to requesting a psychiatric examination for Hefflon.

contacted by Special Agent Brueggemen September 13, 1964, at Iowa, where resides stated stated wisited Heiflon at the City Jail, Toledo, Iowa, just before he was taken into Federal custody at which time Hefflon advised he intended to tell Federal authorities that he had assassinated former President John Fitzgerald Kennedy. Stated believes Hefflon is a mental case, and it is understanding that he has undergone mental treatment in the past; however, has no specific information in this regard. Stated he definitely indicated to so September 15, 1964, when wisited him in the County Jail Toledo, Iowa that he intended to "fake" mental instability.
