THOMSON has advised that he has an employee of his office named OSCAR GRUINBERG who is from South America and has a rich cousin in South America. He considered GRUNBERG to be completely loyal to the United States but he wanted GRUNBERG's name to be in the possession of the FBI in view of his foreign connections; further, that he considers GRUNBERG to be a loyal and honest employee. THOMSON stated he sometimes thinks the Russians are reading his mind because some of the things that he thinks in solitude he later reads in the newspapers.

THOMSON was thanked for his information and was advised that results of FBI investigation are confidential by law. He
