TEXAS OIL MEN SMEARED Along With All Dallas Policemen

The Party's getting rough on the Assassination Front. Morris A. Bealle's latest blockbuster **GUNS OF THE REGRESSIVE RIGHT** appears to have hit the nail right on the head by constructing the murder plot and laying it right on the lap of what Sen. Goldwater characterized as the "Eastern financial aristocracy." For this cabal has blocked every effort of the book industry to publish this potential best seller of the Century, but has also been able to block its national distribution to paperback racks and news depots. Despite this blackjack this "suppressed" and verboten volume has already sold 5,600 copies, all from advertising in **CAPSULE NEWS** and word-of-mouth advertising.

So, in order to draw attention away from the stone and mortar canyons of New York City, the Rock Mob has just put out a book of their own intended to counteract the intelligence **GUNS** is taking to its readers. This is in the form of a book titled **WHO KILLED KENNEDY? STATE OF THE NATION---President Johnson's State of the Union message Monday was received with mixed emotions by all who heard it. Its many inconsistencies and vaguities were overlooked by those on the Democratic side of the aisle. It seemed they had an organized cheering section, for he was interrupted 57 times for applause, most of which sounded to television viewers like the canned applesauce dispensed from radio and television studios. The Realists Right of both parties, sitting at home radios and T-V sets, took a more realistic view of it. And there were millions of them.

What disappointed most American families was that he offered nothing new on the Mess in Viet Nam, which was launched by the Rockefeller-Eisenhower Administration and continued by Kennedy's and his. American boys are still to be conscripted, and sent to this SE Asia pest hole to be killed by snipers' bullets just as President Kennedy was. He didn't even offer an excuse for keeping up this sickening status quo. Mixed emotions greeted his "master plan" to invite Khrushchev's successors to visit the United States and his intimation that he will visit their countries if they will visit his. Ho Hum, was the general reaction.

He promised to spend \$1 1/2 billion of taxpayers' money to duplicate and mess up county and city educational activities. Double talk barged into the address when he said would propose changes in the Taft-Hartley Act which permits states to pass right-to-work laws. What these changes are to be he didn't say, but those 37 varieties of red and pink surrounded the White House.

ONE OF THE RIKINSIVE RIGHT proved to anyone, intelligent or not, that no Dallas policeman had anything to do with the shooting.

And it proves that Harrison Hunt and Clint Murchison and some of the Texas oilmen had anything to do with it unless some of the lesser ones were mixed up with the Rock Mob in its Council of Foreign Relations, or in some other way.

And it shows conclusively that neither the Secret Service nor the FBI were in any way negligent, as the Warren Thing says by innuendo.

The News Trust, spearheaded by the American News Company, of Canal St., New York, with its branches in every state, and every large city, in the country, has had its "stop order" on GUNS from the start.

This was to be expected since it is owned by those of Rockefeller people.

But unexpectedly the independent news agencies, which are supposed to distribute books and magazines that the Trust snoots, have been "alerted" or intimidated or ordered not to make distribution of GUNS either.

When it was offered to the District News Company here, the manager was not even gentlemanly. He refused to read it.

Boorishly he claimed there are a hundred Kennedy books out. Actually GUNS doesn't even mention Kennedy's name in its story.

He had obviously been "reached".

The reader, who ordered 1,000 of the Lucks after reading her first one, says if GUNS is widely distributed enough, it can mean the end of our invisible Government as such.

GUARD MOUNT IN THE GOP---Left wingers took over the Republican machinery in the House of Representatives Monday when they mustered enough strength to kick out the Party's colorful leader (Halleck of Indiana) and install the left winger and House of Rockefeller stooge (Ford of Michigan). This was hailed in many newspaper quarters as a replica of what happened in 1959 when "Pussyfoot Joe" Martin of Massachusetts was sacked in favor of Mr. Halleck himself. The sacking was there but the replica wasn't. In spite of the 52 subversive votes for Foreign (Rockefeller) Aid, five more than Ford has cast, Mr. Halleck is the more conservative and progressive leader of the two.

To start with he doesn't have the stigma of having served the Rock Mob on the Warren Commission, formed to direct public attention away from the obvious facts of the Plot to Assassinate President Kennedy and its successful carryout. Mr. Ford does. He permitted his name to be used on a Cover-Up Report, such an obvious hoax that four out of five told ABC's radio pollsters they didn't believe it. But the motions the "commission" went thru served to prevent any official investigation and to close the book with none of the pertinent questions involved answered.

The reasons the "Young Turks" (socialists and Communists) gave for ousting the capable Halleck were vague. Not to say that Ford isn't just as capable. To get it on the floor required a petition signed by 218 Members, something hard to do because of the wheeling and dealing among Members. This rule has prevented a lot of bad legislation from coming to the floor where a majority could be pressured and intimidated into voting for it. It has also prevented a lot of good measures from coming to the floor. Anyhow, Communists can't squawk now that the Congress isn't allowed to vote on their pet subversive measures.
