INFORMATION CONCERNING

At 11:35 P.M., today, the captioned individual telephoned the Bureau and spoke with SA William C. Maupai, extra duty supervisor, Special Investigative Division.

Mr. Meyland spoke in a slurred, indistinct and rambling fashion. He stated that he had just been smitten by an inspiration. He said that he believes President Kennedy's murderer came from Cuba and that he used an Italian rifle. He had no further information to furnish in this regard.

Mr. Meyland went on to state that he worked for [REDACTED] and Company for 35 years, has recently retired and has recently married for the second time. He furnished no further information.
