Mr. ROLLAND H. OSBORNE, Special Agent in Charge, U. S. Secret Service, Denver, today advised Denver FBI that ELIAS MITSIS was on a bus in Albuquerque, New Mexico on Sunday evening, 2/28/65, when he was arrested by Albuquerque Police Department for apparently creating some sort of a disturbance. After being taken into custody MITSIS requested to call the White House and consequently Secret Service in Albuquerque was notified by Albuquerque Police Department. MITSIS gave an address of 3023 Cherry Street, Denver, Colorado, to the Albuquerque Police Department according to OSBORNE. When the Secret Service in Albuquerque obtained the Denver address they in turn contacted Mr. OSBORNE.

It is noted Mr. OSBORNE was furnished a copy of Denver's 2/26/65 LHM.

At 12:30 p.m. today Mrs. KIKI MITSIS, 3035 Eudora Street, Denver, telephonically contacted the Denver Office with the following information:

She is the mother of ELIAS MITSIS, who is generally known as LOUIS. She said today she had contacted Mr. BOB TIMMONS, owner of the property at 3023 Cherry Street, Denver, with whom LOUIS resided. TIMMONS told her LOUIS had left Denver 2/27/65, for Albuquerque to visit his aunt, HELEN KOUTOURAS, an employee of the Panorama Cafe there.

Mrs. MITSIS said TIMMONS advised her that LOUIS had been arrested in Albuquerque on Sunday, 2/28/65, and is currently in the County Indian Hospital in Albuquerque. TIMMONS said that LOUIS was on his way from Albuquerque to Phoenix "to see GOLDWATER." Mrs. MITSIS said she spoke to her son at the hospital and he seemed calm and in the conversation told her he had contacted the FBI in Denver on Friday, 2/26/65. The purpose of Mrs. MITSIS' call to the Denver FBI Office was to ascertain whether her son had contacted this office.

Mrs. MITSIS was advised her son had called this office on 2/26/65, and was subsequently interviewed at his home pursuant to his request.

During the course of conversation with Mrs. MITSIS she was asked whether her son has ever shown any evidence of violence, had ever been arrested, or was ever under any psychiatric treatment. She stated to her knowledge he had never been arrested nor been in any trouble and she did not believe he had ever been under any psychiatric care.

She stated that he was extremely fond of President KENNEDY and had met him on one occasion in Denver and again, having attended a press conference at the White House in the Summer of 1963, and LOUIS took the assassination of President KENNEDY very hard.

The above information is being furnished to Albuquerque in the event they should be contacted by ELIAS MITSIS while he is in that area.

LHM is not being submitted since information set forth above was not received from ELIAS MITSIS, as was the case with the information contained in Denver's 2/26/65, LHM.
