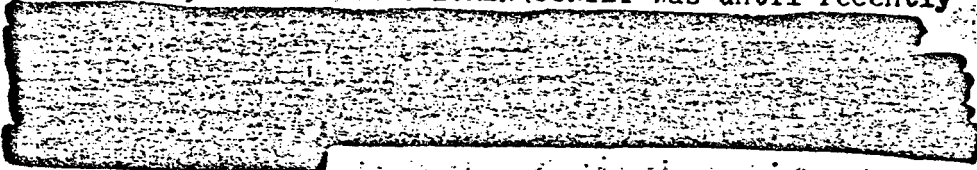

Enclosed for the Bureau are seven copies; for Dallas two copies; and for Richmond two copies of a letterhead memorandum in captioned matter bearing a sub-caption "GERALD 'JERRY' TAYLOR."

On 2/23/65, Mrs. GERALDINE QUINLAN, in addition to the information contained in the enclosed letterhead memorandum, advised that LOREN CONLEY was until recently



For the information of Richmond, referenced Dallas airtel requested that GERALDINE QUINLAN and LOREN CONLEY be reinterviewed for the purpose of determining whether or not they were present together in QUINLAN's home with GERALD TAYLOR when each of them first heard of the assassination of former President KENNEDY on 11/22/63. During the course of an interview of GERALD TAYLOR, he advised that he, Mrs. GERALDINE QUINLAN, and a mutual friend, known as LOREN CONLEY, were present in Mrs. QUINLAN's home located in Rochester, N.Y. when Mrs. QUINLAN's young son entered with the news regarding the assassination of President KENNEDY.

AT RICHMOND, VIRGINIA

Will interview LOREN CONLEY, [redacted] Street, and determine if he, together with Mrs. GERALDINE QUINLAN and their mutual friend, GERALD TAYLOR, were present in Mrs QUINLAN's home in Rochester, N.Y. when he first learned of the assassination of former President KENNEDY on 11/22/63.

The results of the interview should be reported by means of a letterhead memorandum captioned "GERALD 'JERRY' TAYLOR." The first paragraph of the letterhead memorandum should contain the same information as the first paragraph of the attached letterhead memorandum and in addition the date of the attached letterhead memorandum at Buffalo, N.Y. should also be included.
