Enclosed for Minneapolis and Dallas are copies of a letter bearing a signature which appears to be "Leroy Williams, Sr." and the envelope in which it was sent to the Bureau.

Minneapolis conduct appropriate inquiry. Results are to be furnished to Dallas in insert form and your predication is to be the incoming communication. Williams should be located and interviewed. However, if information is developed which indicates mental instability and would preclude interview this information is to be reported.

Based on information furnished Williams was not identified in Bureau files.
