1. Reference is made to our 19 October 1964 reply to our request for name check. Attached to your reply was the copy of the memorandum, dated I May 1964, which you had sent to USIA. In that memorandum you stated that various anonymous sources had furnished to your Bureau literature being distributed by JOESTEN. In that connection you also mentioned an anneuncement concerning "The Joesten Report--The Truth About the Assassination of President Kennedy."

2. On 29 July 1966 we received a copy of what seems to be the same announcement, addressed to the Director of this Agency. The envelope did not contain the sender's name and ne return address was given. Although the cancellation mark is illegible, we have established by checking the German Zip Code number that the letter was cancelled at Tiengen, Germany. Page 3 of the announcement cites JOESTEN's address which is in the vicinity of Tiengen. A copy of the announcement is attached.

About the Kennedy Assassination, is available only in the German language. The announcement also states that a more comprehensive version in the English language is being proposed in seven volumes, four of which have been completed. Attention is directed to page 3 of the announcement.
